### What is Recycle BC

- Funded by Producers (retailers, manufacturers, restaurants)
- Not-for-profit
- Services 99% of BC households
- Mandate to collect and recycle packaging and paper products
- RDCO collects recycling on Recycle BC's behalf



### Recycling Contamination

- Contract Performance Requirement: 3% or less contamination
- Performance Penalty:
  - \$2500 to \$20,000 per incident, depending on population
  - Maximum of 24 penalties, per community, per year
- Penalties to date:
  - 6 in West Kelowna (\$30,000)
  - 2 in Kelowna (\$10,000)

AND THAT the Board authorize the Chair to send a letter to the Ministry of Environment opposing to changes proposed by Recycle BC that would eliminate existing Recycle BC Depots within the Central Okanagan, and shift costs for the collection of EPR onto local governments.
