Executive Summary:

Background:

Section 32 (1) of the Hospital District Act requires:

A board that proposes to borrow or spend money to meet capital expenditures must prepare, in consultation with the minister, and enact, a capital bylaw permitting the borrowing or spending of that money.

The 2023 – 2027 Five-Year Financial Plan includes seventeen (17) new projects that require a bylaw.
