RDCO Code of Conduct - Policy Review

✓Best Practice

Ensure a set of shared expectations for a policy objective

✓Good Governance

Furthers and promotes responsible conduct with shared principles

✓Legislative Requirement

 Requires local government to consider best practice and good governance with prescribed principles

Considerations

Regulated Principles:

- a) Must carry out their duties with integrity;
- b) Accountable for the decisions that they make, and the actions that they take, in the course of their duties;
- c) Must be respectful of others;
- d) Must demonstrate leadership and collaboration

RDCO Code of Conduct Values:

- a) Integrity
- b) Accountability
- c) Leadership
- d) Responsibility
- e) Respect
- f) Openness

Three (3) Legislative Options

- 1. Establish a Code of Conduct ✓ established in 2011, 2016
- 2. Not establish, or review, a Code of Conduct
 Provide reasons publicly
 Re-consider a review prior to 2026
- 3. Review or refresh an existing Code of Conduct
 Consider the scope; 3 options provided

Review Options

- 1. Full review
 - Identify key principles and establish shared expectations
 - Conduct an analysis with related policy
 - Consider training, education
- 2. Partial review
 - Identify key principles and establish shared expectations
 - Review specific sections of the current Code of Conduct
- 3. Best practices review gap analysis recommended
 - Review the Model Code of Conduct
 - Identify and discuss optional value statements and/or provisions

Recommendations

THAT the Regional Board consider the regulated principles for Code of Conduct as provided in the report from the Corporate Officer dated April 20, 2023;

AND THAT the Regional Board approve a best practice gap analysis review of the RDCO Code of Conduct, Board Policy 1-2016, with the scope as outlined in the report;

AND FURTHER THAT the Code of Conduct review be referred to the Committee of the Whole for discussion and recommendations to the Regional Board.
