Purpose: To adopt Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Area Establishment Amendment Bylaw No.1508 and Ellison Fire Protection Local Service Area Establishment Amendment Bylaw No.1509.

Executive Summary:

Joe Rich Fire Protection Local Service Area Bylaw No.1508 and Ellison Fire Protection Local Service Area Bylaw No.1509 were given first, second and third reading on [September 8, 2022](#).

The bylaws received approval from the Inspector of Municipalities on May 10, 2023, and are therefore presented for adoption. Staff have confirmed with Fire Services that the subject properties have been receiving fire protection since September 8, 2022.
