Purpose: To consider renewing the Mutual Fire Aid Agreement between the RDKB Big White Fire

Department and the RDCO Joe Rich Fire Department

Executive Summary:

In collaboration with the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary, (RDKB), the agreement for the provision of mutual fire aid is proposed to be renewed through to September 30, 2029. Through the proposed agreement, and for mutual benefit of both parties, the Big White Fire Department and the Joe Rich Fire Department will continue to cooperate in the resolution of emergency incidents by providing mutual fire aid when requested by either party.

Recommendation(s):

Regional transportation

THAT the Regional Board approve entering into the Mutual Fire Aid Agreement between the Regional District of Central Okanagan (Joe Rich Fire Department) and the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary (Big White Fire Department), in the form attached to the Report from the Director of Protective Services, dated September 26, 2024;

Background:

The Regional District of Central Okanagan and the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary have had a Mutual Fire Aid Agreement in place since 2014 to authorize the cooperation between the Big White Fire Department and the Joe Rich Fire Department. This mutually beneficial agreement allows either party to bring in resources, in a timely manner, that may be necessary for suppression of a large incident.

Under the agreement renewal, the ability to share resources between the two fire departments for large suppression incidents will remain in place.

Considerations:

Organizational/External:

The timely deployment of adequate resources for a large or sustained incident is critical. Coordination between two Regional Districts to provision these resources ensures that services are available while remaining fiscally responsible.

Financial:

Cost sharing by avoiding duplication of resources used on a low frequency basis.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

The Regional Board has the authority to enter into agreements with other Regional Districts.
