Dear Blair Ireland:

I am writing to follow up on our meeting at this year's Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) Convention on September 19, 2024. Thank you for taking the opportunity to meet with Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness representatives; it was good to hear firsthand the matters of importance to you and your community relating to year-round funding for Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) facility and training.

I want to acknowledge the impacts within the Regional District of Central Okanagan (RDCO) during the 2023 wildfire season and the support that RDCO communities have offered as host communities during other events.

The Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF), which is administered through UBCM, has a funding stream to support the purchase of equipment and supplies required to maintain or improve EOCs and to enhance EOC capacity through training and exercises. This funding stream can cover up to 100 percent of the cost of eligible project activities, with a maximum contribution of \$40,000 per applicant. Applications are currently being accepted until February 28, 2025. If you have questions on the CEPF, you may contact UBCM at cepf@ubcm.ca or (604) 270-8226 [ext. 220].
