# Solid Waste Management Plan 5-year Effectiveness Review

 Regional Districts are required to prepare 10-year solid waste management plans (SWMP) and submit for final approval to the Ministry of Environment (MoE)

 The RDCO's approved 2020 SWMP is required to be reviewed after 5 years and submitted to the MoE by December 31, 2024



- Policy and land use planning related to waste management


### Plan Target – Disposal Rate Per Capita

#### Disposal Compared to other RD's




## **Initiatives Status** 17 Complete 6 In Progress 24 initiatives 1 not started

### Key Accomplishments

- Curbside recycling turned over to Recycle BC (effective May 2026)
- Feasibility study for food waste collection (2022)
- Phase 1 & 2 public engagement on food waste collection (2023-2024)
- Public awareness and recycling contamination reduction programs
  - Full time Waste Ambassadors
  - Al pilot
  - Pop-up depots for areas under served
  - Book recycling program
- Multifamily recycling study and tool kit
- Construction, Renovation & Demolition Market Capacity Assessment
- Biomass Inventory Study


## Recycle rate per capita



#### **Initiative Not Started**


 Investigate requiring all contractors for construction and demolition (C&D) projects to develop waste management plans to meet specified recycling target.

## What's in our Waste – 2024 Waste Composition Study





#### Curbside Glass & Flexible Plastics

- Currently depot only items
- Recycle BC is expecting to add curbside glass and flexible plastics starting in May 2026



### WildsafeBC Programming

- 2018 2019 Westside only program
  - West Kelowna, Peachland, Electoral Area West (curbside)
- 2020 current region wide program expansion
  - Late spring end of November
  - Solid waste focused
  - Bin tagging, school education, event participation
  - Signage in neighbourhoods
  - Bylaw enforcement support
- Identified need for year-round coordinator
