Purpose



To seek board direction regarding potential amendments to Consolidated Bylaw No. 1066.

Directive



As directed by the Regional Board staff have reviewed Bylaw No. 1066 – Consolidated – Fire Prevention and Regulations and other associated documents. The review aimed to determine if the minimum ventilation index threshold for open burning should be amended to be in line with the provincial standard of fifty-five (55). Additionally, hectare size requirements for open burning were also reviewed.

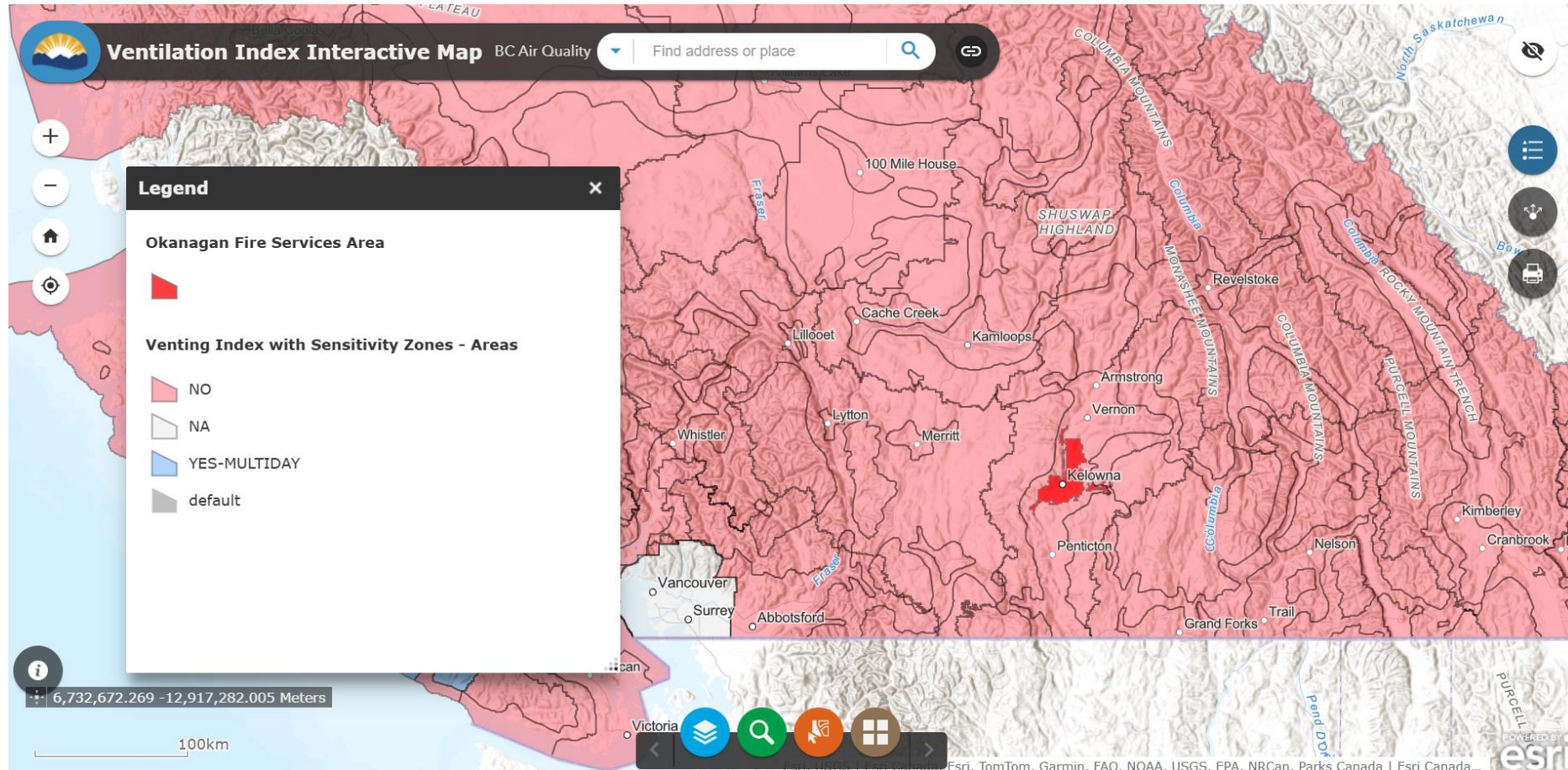
