Progress since Summer 2024

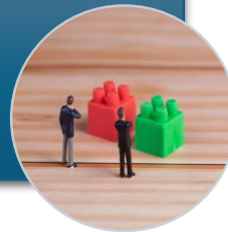
- ⑩ Established availability callout list for high hazard seasons

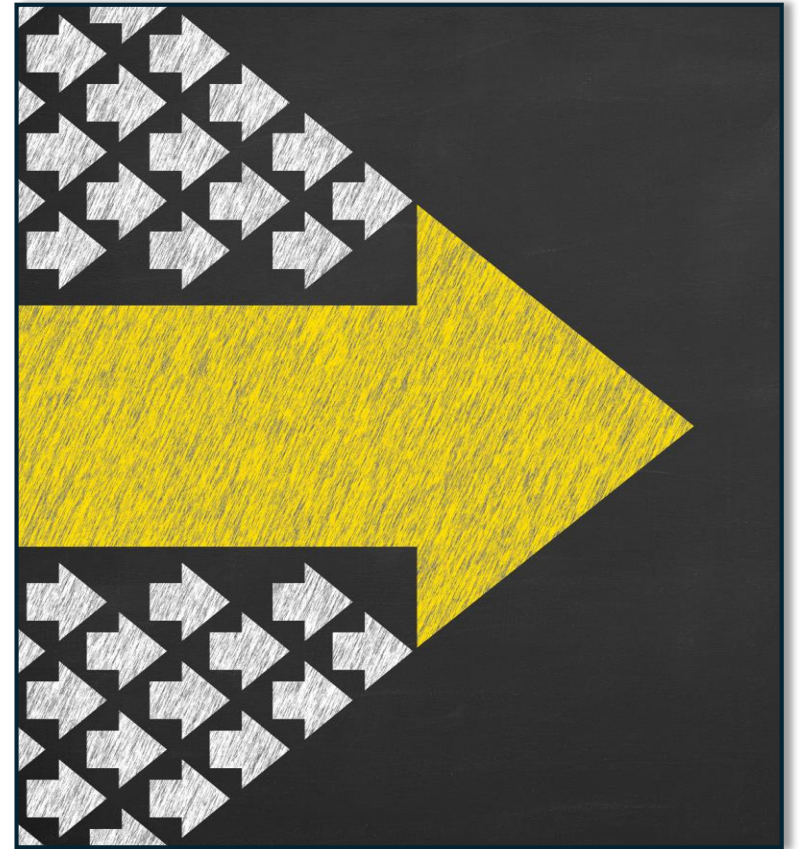
