To amend a section of the regulations in Building Bylaw No. 1482 to shorten the duration that an incomplete application remains active before it expires.

Building Bylaw Proposed Amendment

Change the length of time an incomplete BP application will be retained from 180 days to 60 days.



Building Permit Duration



Once a permit is issued, it remains valid for up to two years subject to the following requirements:

The first inspection is completed within 6 months from permit issue date

The work is not suspended or discontinued for more than one year



All permits expire two years after the date of issue; with the possibility of a one-time extension of up to 1 year (for an additional fee).

Benefits of Reduced Expiration Time



Streamlined Process: Encourages applicants to submit complete and accurate applications initially, reducing the need for follow-up & speeding up the review process.

Efficient Resource Management: Manages administrative resources effectively by prioritizing active applications.



Prevention of Delays: Prevent delays in the approval process and the start of construction projects.



Improved Accuracy: The shorter timeframe may encourage applicants to ensure completeness of their applications and submit all necessary documentation upfront.
