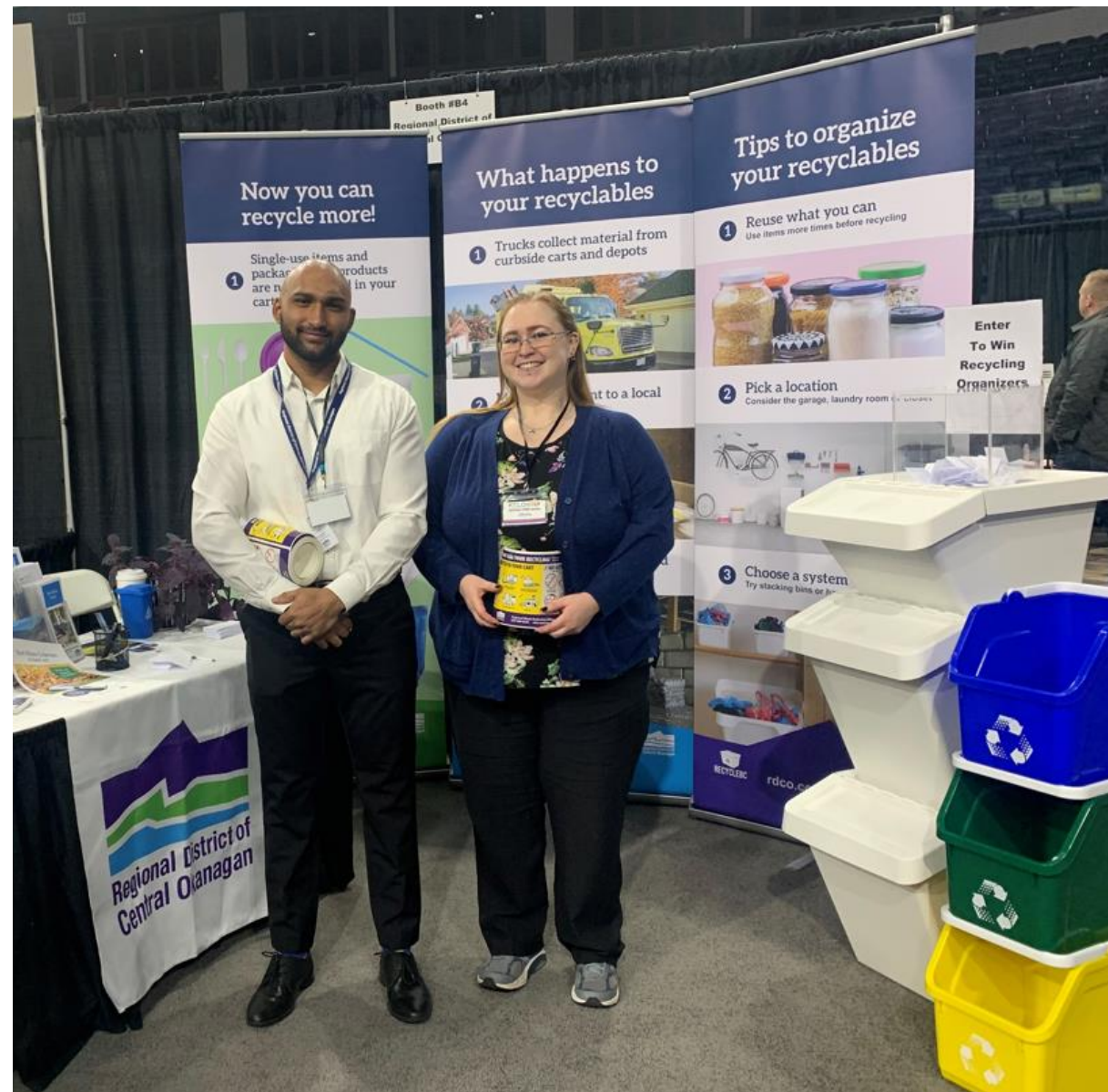
Background – Solid Waste Bylaw No. 1253



- Adopted in 2009
- Last amended in 2023
- Member municipalities have similar Bylaws
- May 1, 2026 - Recycle BC will provide curbside recycling
- Triggered an extensive review and update of the Solid Waste Management Bylaw

Objectives of Update

- Modernize terms
- Improve clarity
- Reflect current operations
- Remove outdated references and other general housekeeping



Key Changes



- New types of recycling containers
- New clause for lawful disposal of material (illegal dumping)
- Safety requirements for on-site behaviour at all RDCO waste facilities
- Rate increase from \$3 to \$5 each for tires with rims at Asquith Road Transfer Station
- Rate increase from \$20 to \$23 each for mattresses at Asquith Road Transfer Station

This update did not change...

- Curbside Collection rates
- North Westside Transfer Station rates
- Trader's Cove Transfer Station rates
- Service levels
