#### What are Friends Groups

Regional Parks Services has partnerships with over ten Friends groups. Friends Groups are volunteer groups that play a vital role in areas such as:

- Land acquisition
- Fundraising
- Clean-up projects
- Park improvements
- Trail building
- and more

#### Why the Need for a Friends Group Handbook?

The formation of more Friends groups in recent years has highlighted the need to:

- 1. Complete MOUs with multiple Friends groups;
- 2. Formalize and guide the annual planning and reporting of ongoing Friends group activities;
- 3. Identify priority park projects;
- 4. Identify fundraising initiatives.

## Friends Groups in Action

#### What will a Handbook accomplish?

- Guide the formation of Friends groups by providing a framework for operating as a non-profit organization.
- Establish an application process to guide new groups as they form.
- Introduce annual planning and reporting procedures.
- Support and grow Friends groups which in turn enhance Regional Parks.

#### Capacity Building Funding Grant

- Matching funds available from RDCO.
- Applications based on annual planning exercises.
- Applications assessed based on value of project to a specific park, benefit to public, and equal distribution among Regional Parks, using the evaluation rubric.
- Grants amounts dependent on applications received and funds available. Initially grants will be limited to \$2,000 per Friends group per year.
- Larger projects could be supported through capital project funding.
