 - Glen Canyon Regional Park





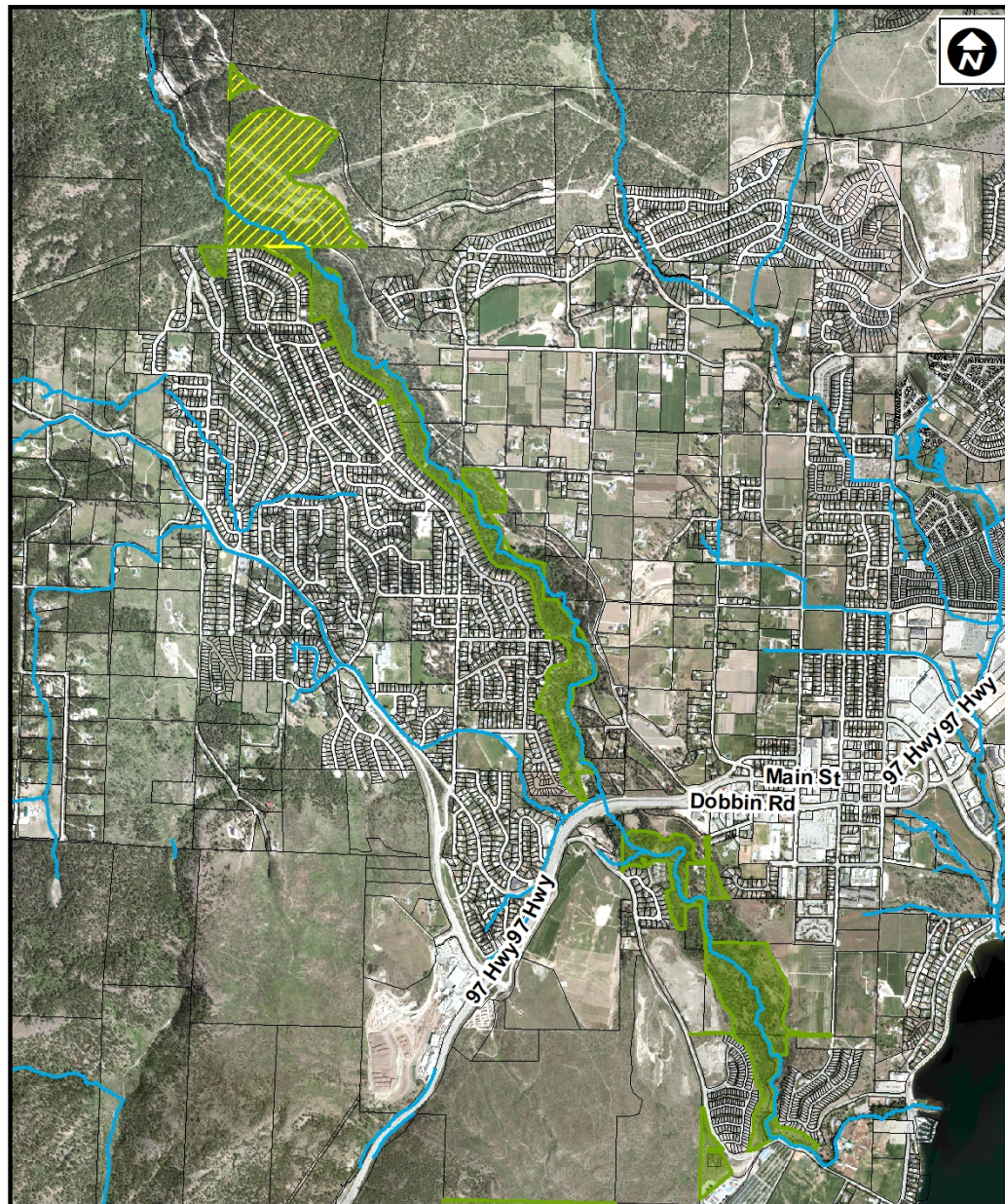
Background:

- Crown License Renewals:
 - Regional Parks – Upland Tenure
 - Due for renewal
 - Renewals Delayed by Province due to Flood Years, Fires and Pandemic
 - Operating Month to Month
 - Province renewing as resources permit
 - 3 more renewals after these


Glen Canyon Regional Park – License Renewal:

- Terrestrial Tenure
- License Area = 32 hectares
- Expired in 2016, extended on month to month basis
- Upper Portion of Glen Canyon at Top of Smith Creek Road
- Requires Board Approval to Renew 30 Year License

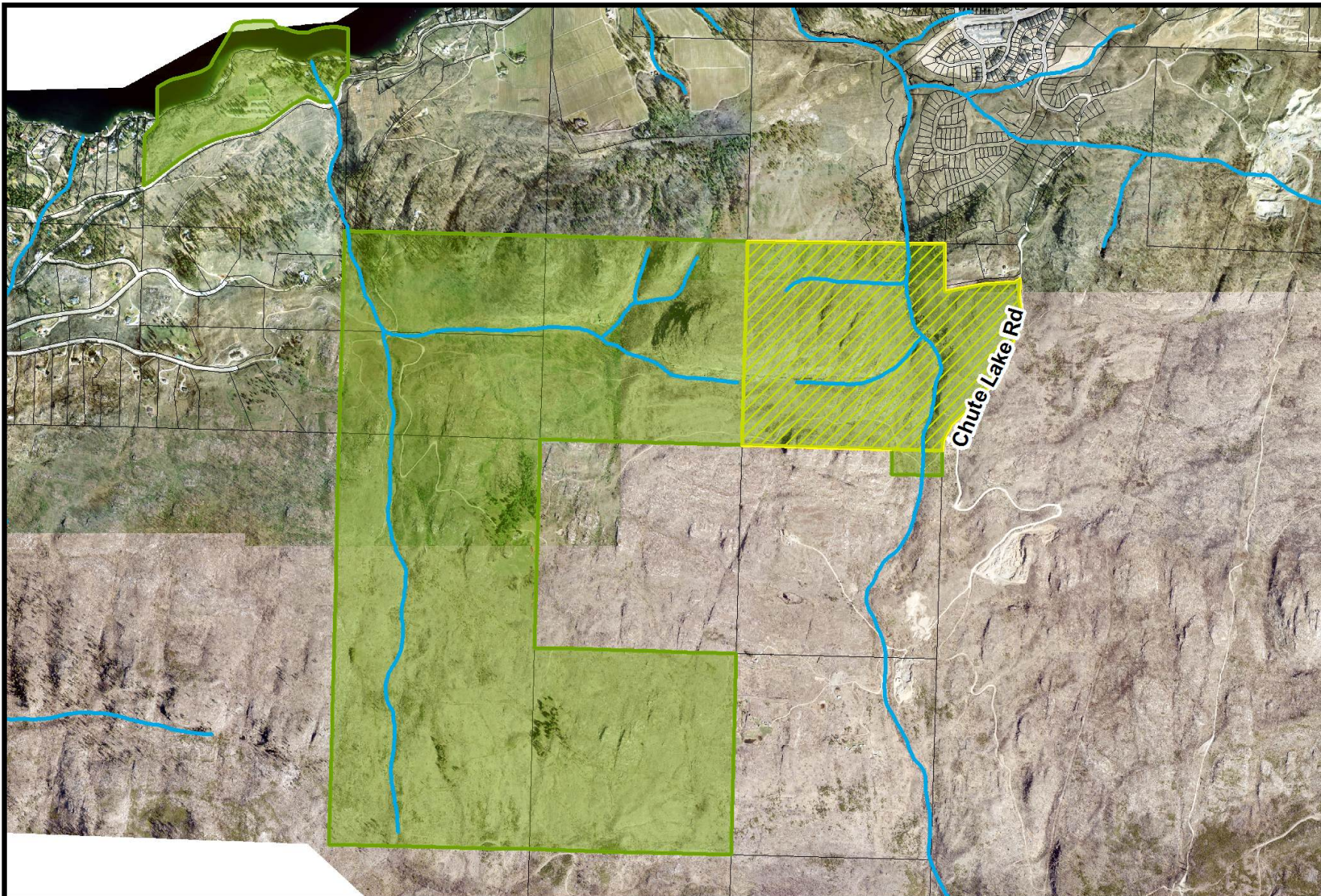
 Crown Land Tenure Areas



Johns Family Nature Conservancy Regional Park – License Renewal:



- Terrestrial Tenure
- License Area = 80 hectares
- Expired in 2018, extended on month to month basis
- Original Cedar Mountain portion
- Trails, Washroom, Climbing
- Requires Board Approval to Renew 30 Year License

Resolution 1 – Provincial Crown Land License Renewal File 3406305 – Glen Canyon Regional Park

THAT the Regional Board agrees to acquire a 30-Year License of Occupation with the Province of British Columbia for Glen Canyon Regional Park over the land that part of District Lot 3479, Osoyoos Division Yale District, containing 32.0 hectares, more or less for regional park purposes.

Resolution 2 – Provincial Crown Land License of Occupation Renewal File 3409050 – Johns Family Nature Conservancy Regional Park

THAT the Regional Board agrees to acquire a 30-Year License of Occupation with the Province of British Columbia for Johns Family Nature Conservancy Regional Park over the land; That Southwest ¼ of Section 14 together with the remainder of the Southeast ¼ of Section 14, all of Township 28, Similkameen Division Yale District, containing 80.0 hectares, more or less for regional park purposes.
