Subject: Authorization to Enforce Additional Bylaws – Engineering Staff

Purpose: To authorize specific staff members to enforce provisions of bylaws outlined in Schedule

1 of the RDCO Ticket Information and Utilization Bylaw No. 435.

Executive Summary:

At the December 6th Regular Board meeting, four staff from Engineering Services were appointed as Bylaw Enforcement Officers to enforce applicable RDCO bylaws as they relate to their area of expertise.

Upon further review, it was noted that there are three additional bylaws staff can enforce related to solid waste management and water systems. As the staff have already been appointed as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, additional Bylaws for enforcement are being requested for Board approval.

- 1. Westside Sewer System Bylaw No. 1315; and
- 2. Water Systems Fees and Regulations Bylaw No. 1370.
