
# JUNE SPRINGS & LAKESHORE ROAD - Fire Service Agreement


### Purpose

 To seek Regional Board approval to renew the Fire Service Agreements with the City of Kelowna for the June Springs and Lakeshore Road - Fire Protection Areas for a five (5) year term.

## Fire Service Agreement - Renewal

- Agreement provides fire protection to:
  - June Springs Road and
  - the South end of Lakeshore Road
- Renewal of an existing agreement which began in 2004
- Term:
  - This Agreement shall be for a (5) five-year term for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2027.





## Fire Service Agreement

#### Agreement includes:

- Fire Protection provided by the City of Kelowna Fire to structural fire alarms.
- Same declared service level as other areas of the City

#### Agreement does not include:

- Wildfire or interface fire suppression to land on which there are no improvements.
- Wildfire response is addressed in the Emergency Mutual Aid Agreement covered by all fire departments within the RDCO.

## **Estimated Cost**

Shall not exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value.

- There is also an administrative fee of 15% calculated into the agreement.
- In 2021:
  - June Springs: Contract Value = \$14,211 (or \$0.5718/\$1000)
  - Lakeshore Road: Contract Value = \$23,919 (or \$0.5310/\$1000)

### Recommendations

■ THAT the Regional Board approves entering into the Fire Service Agreement with the City of Kelowna for the Lakeshore Road and June Spring Road fire protection area, in the form attached to the report from the Director of Engineering dated January 24, 2022;

 AND THAT the Board Chair and Corporate Officer be authorized to execute the Agreement.
