Challenging year in prioritizing capital

- Aging infrastructure and equipment
- Strategic priorities and service level growth
- Rising Costs

Projected Escalation 2022 - 2024

Projected escalation over the next three years

- 2022 2023: 14 to 16 %
- 2023 2024: 12 to 14 %
- 2024 2025: 10 to 12 %

Mitigation strategies:

- Match the delivery model to project complexity, schedule and risks;
- Assess market conditions and supply chain factors frequently and make informed decisions;
- Increased due diligence in procurement to consider contractor commitments, liquidity, and other factors.


Pharmacy Upgrade Kelowna General Hospital

- Renovations and upgrades to bring KGH Pharmacy in compliance with national regulations
- Includes
 - Upgrades to HVAC systems
 - Development of hazardous drug storage room
- Total RHD request = \$780K



Boiler Replacement and Building Automation System Upgrade Brookhaven Care Centre

- Efficiency upgrades to boiler room
 - Replace two existing main boilers
 with condensing boilers
 - Replace building automation
 - Replace kitchen make-up air unit
- Approaching 30 years in service
- Co-benefits of carbon reduction
- Total RHD Request = \$764K

Chiller Replacement Brookhaven Care Centre

- 1996 model chiller significant repairs in recent years
- In 2021 it failed altogether
- Negative impact on patients & staff
- Scope includes replacement of chiller and ancillary equipment
- Total RHD Request = \$258K







Strathcona Heating Plant Replacement Kelowna General Hospital

- Replace existing steam boilers with condensing boilers
- Add heat recovery chillers to:
 - Increase cooling capacity
 - Recover heat for use in facility
- Co-benefits of carbon reduction

• Total RHD request = \$560K

Downtown First Nations Health Centre - Planning

Planning project

- Provide culturally integrated healthcare to serve local indigenous community members
- Development of a medical centre on the University of British Columbia (UBC) downtown Kelowna campus
- Planning to explore integration of clinical, support and administrative areas in partnership with UBC
- RHD funding request = \$60K



MRI Replacement and Addition Kelowna General Hospital

- Major project for MRI Services at KGH
- Construct building expansion
- Replace current MRI (2002 model)
- Install 2nd MRI
- New space meets newest MRI safety standards
- RHD Funding Request = \$10.3M





CT Scanner Replacement Kelowna General Hospital

- Replace 2006 model CT Scanner
- Includes renovation of space to:
 - Meet current radiation safety standards
 - Meet safe patient handling requirements
- RHD Funding Request = \$1.3M



Equipment Management System - OR Kelowna General Hospital


- Replace equipment management systems in all 5 Operating Rooms in the Centennial Building of KGH
- Entire system includes:
 - Booms
 - Video Monitors
 - Exam Lights
 - Cameras
 - Camera Integration
- Phased approach over two years due to cost
 - Phase 1 includes **bolded** items above
- Total RHD request = \$480K





Laboratory Middleware

- Software that connects laboratory analyzers and the Laboratory Information System
- Enhances and streamlines operations
- Integrate and automate repetitive tasks
- Existing project budget increase required
 - Additional RHD request = \$156K



IH-Wide Digital Health

- IH-Wide initiative with benefits distributed equally across all regions
- Cost allocation to the RHD's based on population
- Central Okanagan allocation = 27% (\$1.03M)



IH-Wide Digital Health

Includes multiple elements

- Network infrastructure refresh
- Analytics strategy enablement
- Continuation of MyHealthPortal expansion
- Primary & Community Care Transformation
- Telephone system replacements
