The proposed project location will be a portion of the existing Brenda Mine site located 35 km west of Kelowna in south central British Columbia. Access for the mine site is immediately off of Hwy 97C. The compost facility operation will share this access and maintain the main road past the water treatment plant to the compost site since that operation will account for the majority of

the traffic.

The remainder of the closed mine site is governed by a MEMPR permit and will maintain all other roads required for ongoing closure and reclamation activities.
