Purpose: To appoint a Bylaw Officer to enforce provisions of bylaws outlined in Schedule 1 of the

RDCO Ticket Information and Utilization Bylaw No. 435

Executive Summary:

In order to enforce provisions of the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information and Utilization Bylaw No. 435, there is a requirement for the Regional Board to appoint, by resolution, staff members as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the Regional District of Central Okanagan.

Kim Mussenden was previously appointed as a seasonal Bylaw Enforcement Officer enforcing the Noxious Weed Control Bylaw No. 179 and Noxious Insect and Pest Control Bylaw No. 1202. Board approval of the 2022 RDCO Budget resulted in a new Bylaw Enforcement Officer position and Kim was the successful internal candidate.

An appointment by resolution of the board is required to delegate the authority to Ms. Mussenden to enforce the designated bylaws as detailed in Schedule 1 of the Ticket Information and Utilization Bylaw No. 435.

THAT the Regional Board appoint the following Regional District employee as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer to enforce the designated service bylaws as outlined:
