Program Update

- Grants for ESS ERA 2.0
 - Support the community during evacuations online
- EOC staged for turn key activation
 - Supporting virtual and in person
- All key staff prepared, and availability lists being maintained.
- A dry start to spring with some snow pack still melting with anticipated drier and hotter conditions escalating fire risk going forward.



BROADCAST INSTRUSIVE ALERTING IN BC

- Education and Training Local Governments and First Nations in May
- Only used for Floods and Wildfires
 - Lives or public safety are at risk
 - EOC activation from Director's authorization for RDCO
 - Need to consider regional partners
 - Specific message prepared
 - BC Wildfire can also action this to support tactical evacuations



Staffing Changes

- Staffing changes within Kelowna Fire
 - Sandra Follack, Deputy Chief, Communications and Emergency Management
 - Primary responsibility for Emergency Program
 - A/C of Communications support
 - Finance Supervisor (Emergency Management)
 - Responsible as Finance Section Chief during activation
 - ESS Manager
 - ESS Volunteer support and responsible for day-to-day operations, preparation and EOC readiness



Staffing updates

- Changes to staffing during long duration events
 - Discipline to ensure staff are rotating out
 - Shadow new employees to ensure depth
 - Time unit clerk to schedule all sections
- Contractors
 - Skilled staff from area utilized for longer duration events ie flooding
- Provincial support from other Emergency Operations Centres
 - Reach out to other LGA that are not impacted
