Purpose

To consider a Liquor Control & Cannabis Regulation referral for a Temporary Expanded Service Area authorization that permits outdoor liquor service at the beach/marina area of Lake Okanagan Resort.

Background

- Lake Okanagan Resort was opened in 1979
- Comprised of seasonal and permanent residential uses: hotel, wedding venue, spa, restaurant, swimming pools, golf course, beach area, and marina
- Okanagan Beach Club

Compliance History & Complaints

- PSCT formed to respond to health, safety & security concerns through collaboration & coordination
- Lake Okanagan Resort and the Okanagan Beach Club – Compliance and Complaints
- Health & Safety Concerns – RDCO Fire Services / RCMP
