To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting.

**Whereas** the Regional District of Central Okanagan was incorporated by Letters Patent issued on August 24, 1967 (Order in Council 2731/1967), and

**Dhereas** a request has been received by the Minister of Municipal Affairs from the board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan requesting that the voting unit be changed;

Whereas the Minister of Municipal Affairs has recommended the voting unit be changed;

Dow know ye that We do by these presents proclaim and order as follows:

1 The Letters Patent of the Regional District of Central Okanagan issued on August 24, 1967 are amended by repealing paragraph 4 and substituting the following:

### **Voting Unit**

4. The population deemed to be a voting unit is 5 500.
